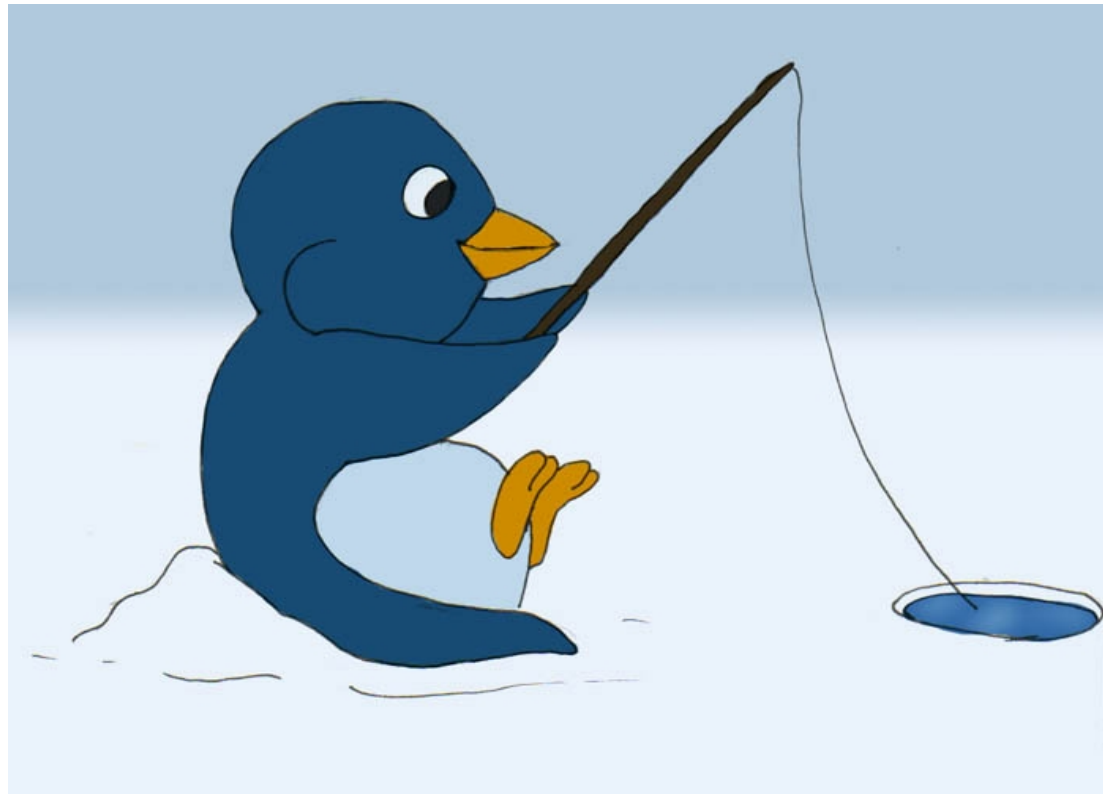
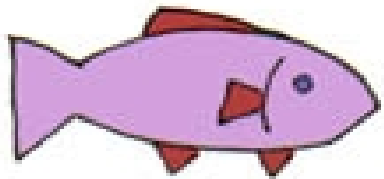
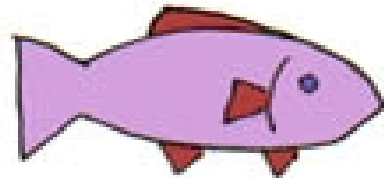
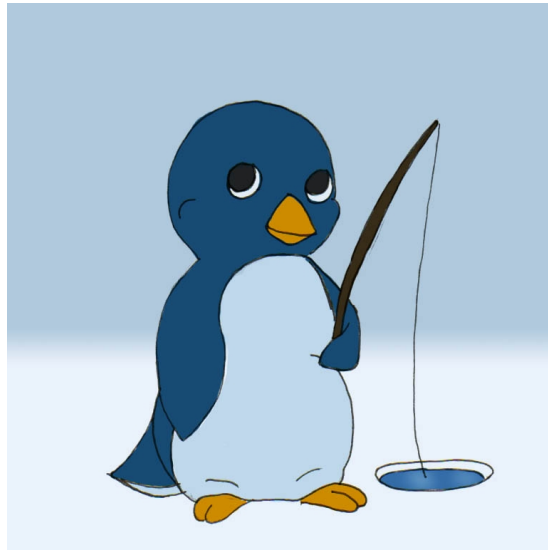


This is Pippin Penguin. He loves fish!

he gets both fish!





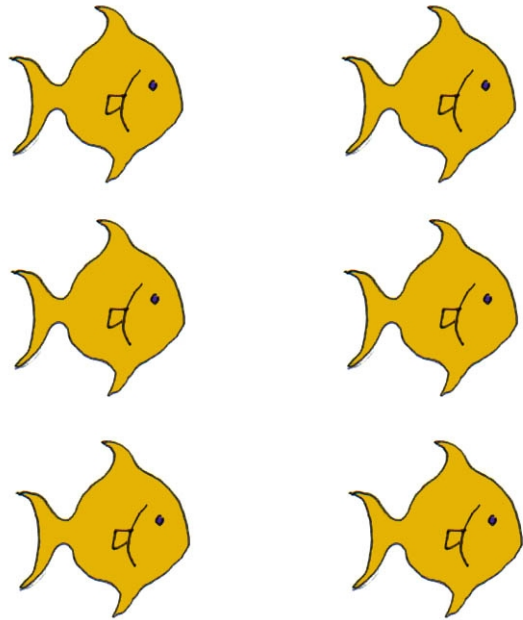

Sometimes Pippin goes fishing with his friend Olly Otter. Together they catch even more fish! Together they catch six fish. How many do each of them get?



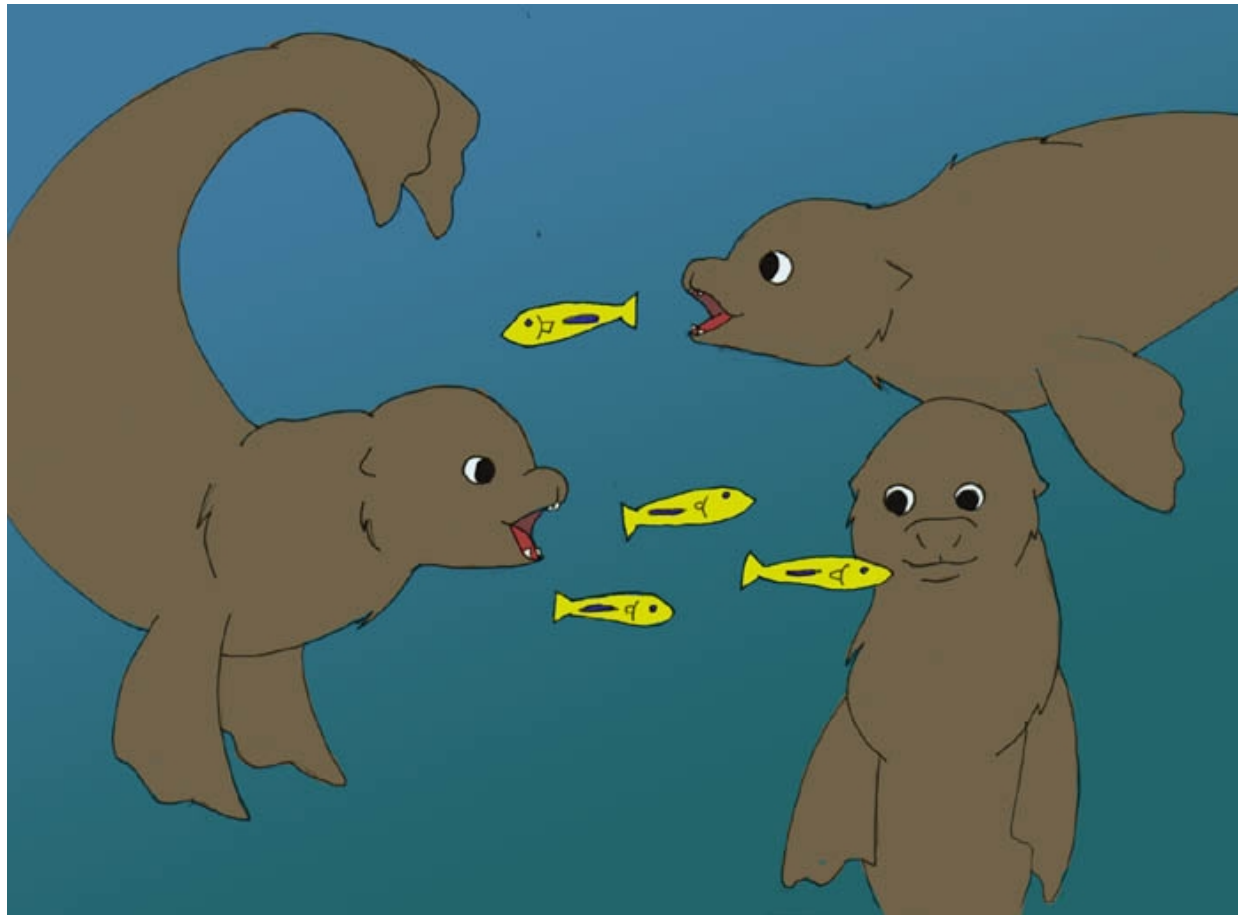


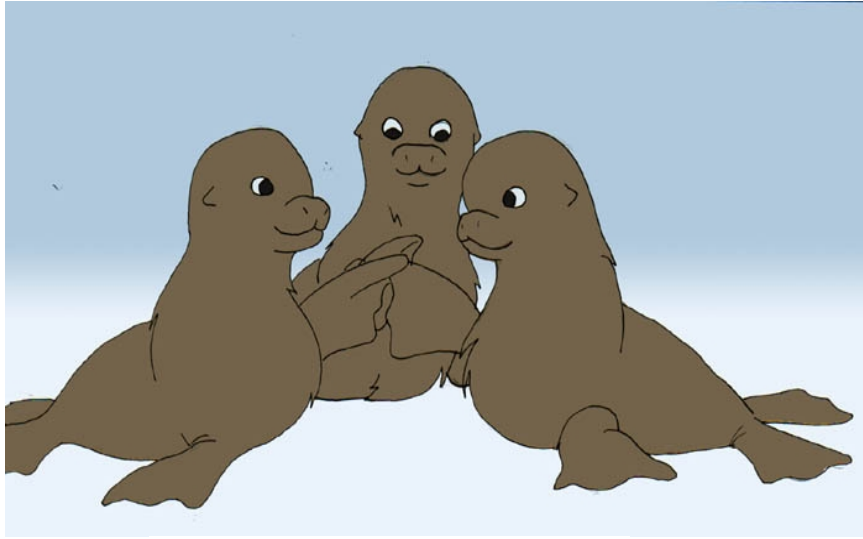

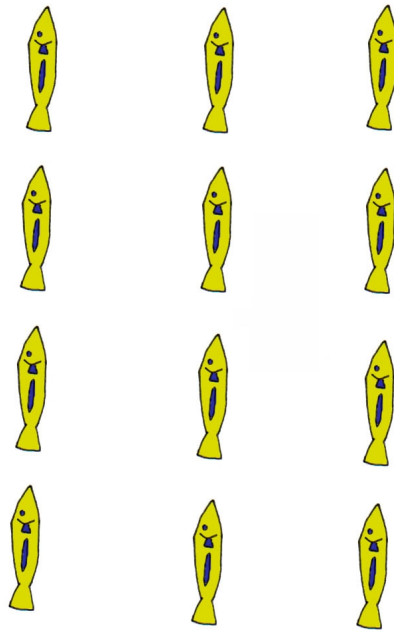
Six fish divided by two fishers equals three fish each!

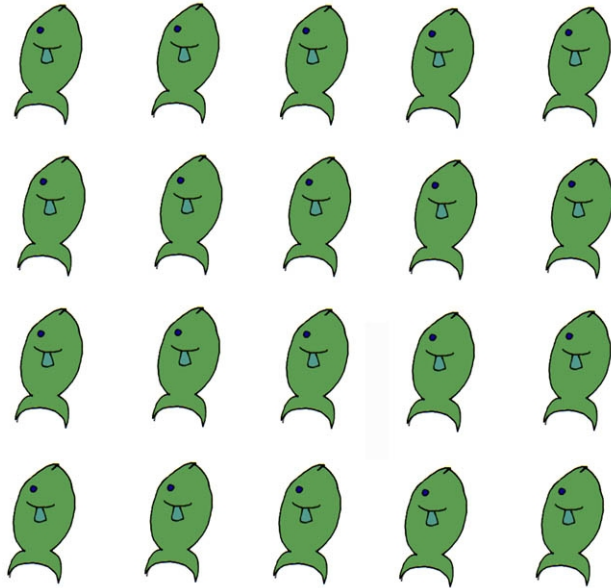
Twelve fish divided by three seals equals four fish each!

$$\begin{array}{r} 20 \\ \div 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

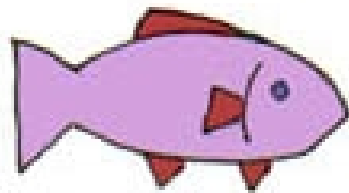
